Haiti after Tropical Storm Hanna, Hurricane Gustav & Hurricane Ike



Desperate Haitians Need Aid!

As a result of the devastation caused by Tropical Storm Hanna and Hurricane Gustav, and most recently Hurricane Ike, hundreds of thousands of famished Haitians are begging for food and water. Many of them have gone without food for days, and safe drinking water is a short supply as fetid carcasses of drowned farm animals bob in floodwaters. Deforested mountains run with mud, dumping vast amounts of water down the hillsides, swamping tin-roofed houses, blowing down fruit trees and ruining stores of food.

Through the "Charitable Fridays" Jean Day program, Doerle's had made a previous donation of \$1,000 this past May 08. That contribution was earmarked for medical supplies needed for an Episcopal Mission trip scheduled this summer. Once again, our company needs to respond to the current crisis in Haiti and the Dominican Republic. Doerle's will be matching the approximately \$500 balance that has accrued in the "Charitable Fridays" account, and will be sending another check of \$1,000 to the Haiti water project.




Specifically, we will be sending a check to Saint Mary Convent in Sewanee, Tennessee, who has spearheaded the

water purification project in Haiti, using a New Life International Purifier system. This water purification system is simple and filters protozoa, helminthes, etc from water by using bio-sand filters to remove the parasites, then a chlorination system to eliminate bacterial and viral contaminants. Sterile water storage is also taught. A by-product of the purification process is sodium hydroxide, better known as lye, which can be used to make soap in a cottage industry or to sterilize sewerage. I believe that our contribution can have the greatest impact if it is designated for water purification and sanitation.

I am grateful for this opportunity to give back. I think it is important for all of us to be reminded of the many blessings and privileges in our lives.
